The Presidential Award for Excellence in Science, Mathematics and Engineering Mentoring

Dr Tayyaba Hasan PhD was recently awarded the prestigious **PAESMEM Award** by **The White House** Office of Science and Technology Policy (OSTP) in concert with the National Science Foundation (NSF).

The specific award: Individual category: Presidential Award for Excellence in Science, Mathematics and Engineering Mentoring (PAESMEM). This achievement reflects the significant contributions she has made to the field of mentoring and in the areas of science, technology, engineering, and mathematics.

Dr. Hasan is one of only 12 individual recipients for this year in the nation. Established by Congress in 1995, this award honors the hard work and dedication mentors exhibit in broadening participation in STEM pathways. PAESMEM specifically honors individuals and organizations that have demonstrated excellence in mentoring individuals from groups that are underrepresented in STEM education and the workforce.

Over the course of Dr. Hasan's career, she has graciously mentored over 300 candidates who are successfully making huge impacts in their fields. Below are few comments from Dr. Hasan's mentees.

"I came as a post-doctoral research fellow, from training in physics. She fostered my abilities in life science translation of my physics knowledge, and showed me how to focus on impactful discoveries, rather that iterative work. Throughout my career, at the Assistant Professor level, transition to tenure track, running graduate programs and even being the Dean of Graduate Studies at Dartmouth, she was a consistent advisor and guide.
